Introduction

LSS works emphasizing on the indigenous knowledge of traditional communities and their representatives, by whom they could sustain their livelihood, keep their community healthy, Management of Natural resources. It is whole new and innovative world of the people, which has to be recognized and given due respect. LSS streamlines the people's power into development action, addressing local issues and fusing a change process. LSS is working in 2 districts i.e Raigarh and Jaspur of Chhattisgarh including 350 villages of 209 panchayats.

LSS is working on the current and several issues of community to avail them a dignified life through their empowerment and leadership development. The works of the organization range from community organization to local self-governance and human welfare. This document represents the activities completed from April 2021 to March 2022, which emphasized on MGNREGA, livelihood, Child Protection, Covid19 Awareness and Relief Distribution etc.

Child Line 1098

LSS successfully implementing the CHILDLine program in raigarh district from 11 years and it is as well known that CHILDLine is 24 hour and in between 60 minutes of phone call the CHILDLine team reaches the place and immediately gives service to the children. CHILDLine Raigarh (LSS) works both for Urban and Rural children but prioritizes the need of the child. The child line team accesses the problems of children through Open-house and outreach process. To sensitize the families and relatives sensitization and information dissemination programs were done.



Activities under Childline program

- ➤ Global Hand Wash Day program: Childline team along with volunteers celebrated Global Handwash Day in 7 different locations as urban area of Raigarh, Pussore, Kharsia along with village Sangitarai, Netnagar, Bhatanpali, and Rengalpali, where handwash demonstration was done including 1700 children and 500 adult. Hand-wash with soap before taking food, after using toilet etc.
- Childline Dosti Saptah: Dosti saptah was celebrated from 14th November to 20th November 2021. The objecti8ve of the program is to cheer up the children after COVID by organizing different activities like signature campaign, Rangoli completion, drawing completion, sports competition. Affect and its prevention, giving mementos, organizing different games like musical chair etc.The program was done including children from



anganwadi, schools and the rehabilitation center(Chakradhar Bal sadan).

- Sensitization workshop with stakeholders (VHSNC, SHGs and PRIs): 09 events Awareness Creation meeting conducted among SHGs members and community members, where Child line toll free no. 1098 and Child line service were discussed in Raigarh city and villages of Gharghoda, Dharamjaigarh, Pussor and Kharsiya block of Raigarh District. In the program, All participants of SHGs were advised to regularly take proper nutritional food (milk, eggs, fruits, pulses, vegetables, fat-rich food items like soybean, peanuts, etc.) to improve the disease resistance of the body and harmful germs, viruses. Through the meeting we have reached to 321 persons.
- ➤ Orientation of Volunteers: 9 meeting were conducted with volunteers during April 2021 to March 2022 where they have made aware about 1098 service, POSCO Act 2012 and its amendment, JJ Act, Child Rights, Good touch bad touch, precautions regarding Covid19 pandemic, Awareness creation on mask, physical distance, need of hand wash, formation and Role of VHSNC, WLCPC, VLCPC, GPLCPC, BLCPC etc.

Displayed Posters

Posters of CWC contact numbers and Child Help line 1098 were displayed in different places Hospitals, Govt. Offices, schools etc.

> Relief distribution:

Sanitary material, mask distributed to 1500 persons including 950 children, Soap and Hand wash, Sanitary pad distributed to 210 adolescent girls of 138 Families, Dry Rashan (grocery) distributed to 550 children of 370 Families. Educational material (Pen, Pencil, Notebook, box, civil dress) distributed to 50 school children.

> MHPSS Training/Activities

To reduce stress and provide mental and emotional support to children MHPSS training have been conducted; 20 participants were participated also Child line team played local games with children. The training was organized on 15th June 2021.

District Level Meetings

Quarterly review meetings were attended by childline staff in which CWC CMHO. DPO, DCPO, DSP, Labour Inspector, CWC members, DCPU staff, CDPOs, Supervisors of WCD, Childline coordinator & team members were present and the topics discussed are nos. of lodged FIR, wall writings, all missing/runaway cases.

Meeting with Superintendent of Police:

On 28th July 2021 childline Director, Coordinator and team member met with respected Mr. Abhishekh Meena, Superintendent of Police. Child Line Director and Coordinator informed the SP about the intervention and services being carried out by Child Line 1098 in the district in cases related to restoration, shelter, protection from exploitation, missing, medical and other children under the age of 18 years. The Superintendent has encouraged the team of Child Line. The Child Line team thanked the Superintendent for the cooperation of the police in the case intervention.

▶ Meeting with Sub Division officer (Revenue):

During the lockdown, permission was obtained from the SDM of the concerned development block before distribution of dry ration to the needy families in Raigarh, Kharsia, Dharamjaygarh and Sarangarh blocks of the Raigarh district.

➤ Meeting with District Program Officer & DCPO (WCD):

Meeting held with the DPO regarding the progress of Child Line, Child marriage cases, Covid19 case, and shelter cases. CWC Functionality also discussed in meeting. During the year we have met 20 times with DCPO regarding Child rescue, CWC Production, Sponsorship scheme, PM Care children's fund, Shelter cases, DCPC meeting agenda etc.



Out Door Training conducted:

On 28 November 2021, One day outdoor training on Child Protection and Child Welfare Services was organized by Child Line Raigarh in Madosilli Gomarda, Sarangarh, in which participants of Child Welfare Committee, District Child Protection Unit, District Women Protection Unit and volunteers were participated.

Annual day celebration of Childline Raigarh (04/08/2021):

The Collab Lok Shakti Samiti has completed 10 years of implementation of Child Line 1098 Project of MWCD. Child line service has entered its 11th year of service. An event was organised on the annual day of the project and cake was cut in the Childline office, in presence of Secretary, Director, Treasures, Childline team; CWC chair person, Members, DCPO and DCPU staff, Media persons were also invited.



National Nutrition Month Program:

The September 2021 was celebrated as Nutrition nutrition Month by the Department of Women and Child Development. In order to that on 28th September, a nutrition awareness program was organized at anganwadi centre, Sant Binoba Nagar, Raigarh in which information was given about the ill-effects of malnutrition and measures to avoid it. Mothers were encouraged to give food items like green vegetables, milk, pulses, fruits etc. to the children in the daily diet in proper quantity.

World Day against child labour

On 12th June 2021, childline celebrated World Day against child labour with children and different shopkeepers in Raigarh. On the occasion of Child Labor Prohibition Day, Lok Shakti Samiti Child Line Raigarh administered various tire shops, dhabas, garages and general store shop operators for not keeping child laborers and if they find such children, then inform them on 1098. A volunteer orientation program was conducted at Kharsia to make understanding on child laborin this program volunteers were imparted knowledge on. Amendment 2016 on Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986,

Methods used for awareness:

CHILDLINE Raigarh use method of awareness during outreach such as- Street Play, Puppet show, Games, Puzzles, Dore to Dore campaigning, Distribution of pamphlets, Sticking Poster on walls, meeting with SHGs, meeting with ward members, School campaigning, meeting with VHSNCs, Rescue operations etc. Demonstrations of Hand wash proper process, Demo of face mask wearing, good touch and Bad touch banner, displayed covid19 preoccupation on banners etc.

High Impact Mega Watershed Project

Lok Shakti Samiti Raigarh is implementing the Mega watershed project from October 2018 in Raigarh District's of 02 block including Gharghoda block as intensive and Kharsia block as Non intensive, Total 16 staff has been appointed for project implementation. Duration of project is 04 yrs. from October 2018 to September 2022.

Objectives:

- 1. Undertaker land and water treatment measures covering approx 7.29 Lakh hectare of catchments in Chhattisgarh state.
- 2. Improve crossing intensity in approx 3.5 lakh hectares of land
- 3. Built capacities of the front line functionaries, PRIs, committee members on Ridge to valley principle of watershed is implementation



"Sustainable Livelihood and MGNREGA"

The Project was implemented in 30 villages of Kharsia block of Raigarh district with 03 staff including 01 Coordinator and 03 Village Animator. In Kharsia block district Raigarh (Chhattisgarh), the organization is coordinating better with the administration and gram panchayat to meet the challenges of employment and livelihood with migrant labor and MNREGA wages in lockdown during the Covid 19 disaster period including the East. Our efforts will further be able to get its sustainable livelihood and employment with MNREGA and if we want to achieve it, then what should be our approach and keeping it in the center, it was continuously talked about at the Panchayat and district level and it came out that in MNREGA The working laborers will have to be taken from self-empowerment to community empowerment and for this, why not a job hunter committee should be made from panchayat to district in which this state. Let's workers sit among themselves, they should have their own bylaws, priority of work and education. Where there is a gap in

implementation, they can work in a pressure group. Put your needs before the administration. With this thought in mind, the labor force federation was formed.

Activities During COVID - 19

With the support of Azim premji foundation Lokshakti Samiti has been implementing activities on

covid-19 awareness and vaccination "Karbo Milke Jatan" in 5 blocks of Raigarh district. Under this project the community was aware on covid-19 symptoms and cure process along with the necessity of vaccination. The community was suggested to go for proper vaccination which was free from government. Door to door survey had been conducted and uploaded on VAXIT app which was developed and provided by Azim premji foundation. Total 522 volunteers and 50 CHWs with 5 block coordinators were working



actively in this program. 31 PHC of 722 villages were covered under this project

Awareness campaign :-

The awareness program for community was initiated on covid-19 under this project. As a it is a new topic for the community at first project volunteer, CHW share project objectives with community, Anganwadi worker, Mitanin, PRIs and VHSNC.

- VHSNC which was formed before but Activated during covid-19 period by project volunteers by regular interaction with them.
- Volunteers and VHSNC together had done 1825 wall writings in villages.
- 755 wall paintings done in panchayat offices, primary school, high school and middle school.
- 3000 PVTG families counselled in dharma Jaigarh block as they were believe in their traditional treatment and at last the tribal of barghat and tedhasemar were get vaccinated.
- 280 families of dharamjaigarh, kharsiya and pussore were being provided dry ration.
- In the road side shops of Nagar panchayat Area, crowded places and busy squares were being instructed by volunteers to were mask, the slogan "No mask, No saman" was being pasted in shops.





• In village PDS shops by help of sarpanch and VHSNC proper distancing was emphasized along with wearing a mask.

1. Screening testing and provide help during Isolation.

- All the volunteers were being provided thermal scanner and pulse oxymeter in the presence of Sarpanch for regular scanning of villagers and for an emergency or isolation cases.
- Safety kit distributed in every anganwadi of project villages in which handwash, sanitizer, mask, gloves and volunteers share the covid-19 safety rules in detailed with the anganwadi workers.
- Volunteers and coordinators helped the isolated patients at their best. Like medicines, ration, regular counselling and monitoring.
- A Covid-19 help centre was established in every project village and 1735 patients were being provided medicines though these help centres285 covid-19 patients were provided ambulance during critical situation. Volunteers were regularly counselling the isolated patients for 17 days. i.e. the days in which they were isolated.



2. Vaccination

- Volunteers regularly facilitating the community to go for vaccination as there were so many myths which was a drawback in vaccination.
- Along with awareness staff were preparing list of non vaccinated person and sending it to PHC for arrangement of camps in the villages for vaccination
- Along with vaccination volunteers were also creating awareness on safe drinking water, personal hygiene, nutrition, and safe menstrual, anaemic and its side effects etc with community.

- Volunteers were working with PHC staff on vaccination day for the effective result which we achieve in Pussore and Kharsiya.
- In pussore block 14837 people get registered as not vaccinated and among them 10102 get vaccinated by the efforts made by volunteers which are 26% of total vaccination.
- In keeping success of Pussore and Kharsiya block in front vaccination program was started in Gharghoda and Sanrangarh block and in one month the difference were covered by volunteers.
- Door to door survey had been conducted in all the project area and uploaded on VAXIT App.

Achievements

- 1. 1800 self made masks distributed by volunteers.
- 2. 100% vaccination in Project area.
- 3. A better relationship developed with health department.

Nutrition

The September month was celebrated as Nutrition Month by the Department of Women and Child Development. In order to that on 28th September, a nutrition awareness program was organized at

anganwadi centre, Sant Binoba Nagar, Raigarh in which information was given about the ill-effects of malnutrition and measures to avoid it. Food items like green vegetables, milk, pulses, fruits etc. were encouraged to be given to the children in the daily diet in proper quantity. During the Poshan month, for the additional nutritional supplements 22 malnourished children were given gram, pulses, soybean badi, jaggery, biscuits, and banana by Child Line and suggested to go to NRC to make such children malnourished.



Child marriage, Labor and trafficking

Lok shakti samiti is doing regular effort on rescue of trafficked children and Child Labor. To stop child marriage and giving protection to children who were forced into beggary in Raigarh district. The following are the detailed data of child marriage and trafficking.
